2009 Crocker-Kingsley Biennial Art Exhibition

The Sacramento Public Library is currently hosting the 2009 Crocker-Kingsley Biennial Art Exhibition through February 6, 2009. This juried art show takes place every two years and is normally held at the Crocker Art Museum. Due to the expansion project currently underway at the Crocker, the Kingsley Art Club approached the Library about hosting this year’s exhibition and the Library readily agreed. The competition was open to any artist currently living in California.

The artwork is on view during regular open hours at the Central Library, and includes paintings, sculpture, photography, prints, and crafts, in a range of artistic styles from representational to abstract to conceptual. A few works are currently on display in the Central Library lobby and the remaining pieces are located on the balcony of the Tsakopoulos Library Galleria.

Library Director Recruitment Update

The Hawkins Company has been retained to lead the search for the Library Director. City managers and the County Executive have met with Bill Hawkins, Principal, to provide their thoughts and input on the development of the candidate profile. June Garcia will be holding stakeholder meetings in late January. At this time, the recruitment is scheduled to be concluded by early May, 2009 with the expectation that the new Library Director would be in place by mid-June.

Authority Counsel Recruitment Update

The Request for Proposal for legal counsel services for the Sacramento Public Library Authority was posted to various websites in December, 2008, with responses due by January 16, 2009. To date, over 100 inquiries have been received requesting the RFP and/or additional information.

Colonial Heights Library – 20th Anniversary

Scheduled for Saturday, January 24th, the Colonial Heights Library will celebrate its 20th anniversary with live jazz music performed by the American River College Jazz Collective, then a family program of music and stories with Voice of the Wood. The community is invited to come for birthday cake and music at 2:00 pm, some brief remarks at 2:30 pm and stay through the program at 3:00 p.m.

Belle Coolegge Library – 50th Anniversary

Fifty years and counting – the Belle Coolegge Library is celebrating its golden anniversary on Saturday, January 31st. The day begins with the Great Backyard Bird Count with the Sacramento Audubon Society at 10:00 a.m., to be followed with a family program including a hoola-hoop contest, Bosco the Magician and a 1950s movie capping the eventful day at 4pm. Brief remarks will be made and birthday cake served at 1:00 p.m. The community is invited to make a day of it, or come for a while to share the excitement and nostalgia.

Teen Services

Over the last five years, the Library has focused on expanding and strengthening teen services and has hired teen services librarians that are making a difference in branches all over the system. As of January 3rd, Rancho Cordova joins the eight other branches that have teen advisory councils (or groups) formed to help librarians plan activities, enhance the spaces for teens in the libraries, and develop materials collections to better meet the needs and interests of the local teens.

Funds from Supporting Partner Organizations

The Library has recently been fortunate to receive donations from the Library’s supporting organizations - the Sacramento Public Library Foundation and the Friends of the Sacramento Public Library, \$24,709 and \$40,000 respectively, to be used for materials. Gifts like these have made it possible for the Library to provide new collections of audio books on mp3 players (*Playaways*) and add to the downloadable audio books and music collection available for use on computers, etc. In mid-December, the Library began offering iPod-compatible downloads of Audio Books with 520 titles and a “soft” opening (no advertising). It was an immediate hit. Recently when staff reviewed usage, 422 titles were currently checked out and 450 more people were waiting to check out one of those 422 titles. This indicates a huge need for downloadable audio for iPod users. The funds from the Foundation will allow the Library to expand this high-demand collection.

In addition, the Foundation distributed funds from the Branch Booster for children’s programs and materials--\$16,422 will be distributed for discretionary uses in the branch libraries and \$16,422 has been sent to the Branch Friends groups for programs or materials or both. The branch supervisors are working with Friends groups to plan for the use of these funds. The donations will have a significant impact on the children’s services and materials collections. These are just the latest in the series of donations to the Library from system support groups.

Mid-Year FY 2008/09 Budget and FY 2009/10 Budget Update

Staff is preparing the mid-year FY 2008/09 Budget status report for the Board. This will include a comprehensive review of revenues and expenditures through December 31, 2008 and any recommended actions for the balance of the fiscal year. This will be presented to the Board at the February 26, 2009 Board meeting.

Staff has initiated the budget development process for FY 2009/10. Staff is also working closely with the City and County of Sacramento to gauge impacts of the economy on their budgets and subsequently on Library funding sources. At this time, it appears that property taxes will decline moderately moving into FY 2009/10. Discussion with City of Sacramento staff indicate that the one-time funding to maintain service levels in the City of Sacramento branches will not be available in FY 2009/10, so the Library may be forced to reduce the City of Sacramento branch operations for all ten City of Sacramento branches in the future. Staff is working closely with City staff to determine if there will be additional recommended reductions in the City General Fund contribution to the Library. Staff will brief the Board in more detail at the February 26, 2009 Board meeting when the mid-year budget is discussed.

E-Commerce Implementation

Payment of fines and fees online went live on November 24, 2008. Since that time, staff has been monitoring the activity on a daily basis. From November 24, 2008 to January 12, 2009, the Library has collected a total of \$17,800. This represents an average daily payment of \$363 since inception, while January has seen an average daily collection rate of \$427 per day. The highest one-day collection was January 10, 2009 at \$705, with four additional days exceeding \$600. The two lowest days were Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day at \$56 and \$75, respectively. Of the payments made to date, 44% were made on computers in Library branches, while 56% were made outside of the Library over the internet. At the current rate of payment, staff estimates an annualized amount of \$120,000 to \$130,000 to be made via online payments.

During the month of January, staff will be installing credit card terminals to enable customers to pay fines with a debit or credit card at the Customer Service desk as well as online. Staff will evaluate the trends to see if this increases the total fines paid.

Cash Handling Policy Update

Staff is working to finalize the Board level cash handling policy, as well as administrative policies and procedures. These are based on the principles presented to the Board at the October 23, 2008 Board meeting.

Implementation of the administrative cash handling procedures requires that a number of tasks be completed simultaneously, such as: ordering, receiving, programming and installing cash registers and credit card terminals; purchasing and installing dual-compartment safes in each branch; and providing separate locking cash boxes for Friends' money raised through sales of used books and other items. Adequate and timely training is the key to successful implementation of the cash handling policies, and is scheduled to be completed by the time the new equipment is installed. Based on this timeline, comprehensive cash handling controls will be in place in all branches by the second week of February 2009. Final administrative and board level policies will be recommended at the February 26, 2009 Board meeting.

Video Surveillance System Update

The Sacramento Public Library now has state of the art video surveillance systems in four branches: Martin Luther King, Jr., Belle Coolegge, Carmichael and Elk Grove. All of these are networked systems, meaning the images are accessed through the Library's intranet and stored on local computer servers. Video data is stored for at least thirty days so incidents can be researched and pertinent video saved well after an incident is reported.

The surveillance systems have been useful for a number of recent incidents:

- A stolen skateboard at ML King was returned to its rightful owner
- A suspect was clearly identified in a customer's laptop theft at the Carmichael Library. Surveillance video was released to law enforcement in accordance with the Library's policies.
- Video from a reported abduction at the Carmichael Library was released to law enforcement and shown to be a hoax.
- Poor behavior at the Belle Coolegge Library has decreased significantly, presumably due to the publicized surveillance system.

Surveillance systems are specified in each of the new libraries: Valley Hi-North Laguna, North Natomas and Pocket-Greenhaven. The success with the systems so far indicates a strong need for expanding the library's capabilities in the future.

Branch Security Audits

Sacramento Public Library Security, in conjunction with All Phase Security, is performing security audits at each branch location. Eight audits have been completed so far with a goal of completing the remaining audits by the end of 2009. The audits examine a number of different aspects of each facility but focus primarily on exterior site conditions and the assigned guard's Post Orders.

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CePTED) principles are used to evaluate the conditions at each branch. Where warranted, landscaping, walls and benches are modified or removed to improve sightlines around each branch. Exterior lighting, including parking lot lighting, is inspected and exceptions are noted for repair. In addition, Branch staff conduct a monthly facility inspection on the third Thursday of each month to identify specific needs, supplementing the findings of the security audits. Staff will present a status report to the Board on the audit results by June 2009.

Employee Performance Appraisals

As of January 22, 2009, 100% of the performance appraisals have been completed! Since August 15, 2008 when the first announcement was posted on the Library's intranet site that all performance appraisals had to be completed by December 31, 2008, system wide 322 performance appraisals were completed in just over four months' time – including probationary employees. This means that 100% of the evaluations were done in one-third the time it would normally take to do them over a 12-month period. It goes without saying that this was a collective effort and could not have been accomplished without the efforts of every single staff member.

Performance Appraisal Instrument Re-Engineering

The Performance Appraisal Re-Engineering committee, comprised of; Arevik Bagdassari, Donald Tucker, Cynthia Phipps, Sarah Dentan, Bridget Laws, Eric Webb, Kathryn Noblet, Rebecca Higgeson, Shari Nichelini, Suzy Murray and Maria Trejo, has been working diligently since June 13, 2008 to update the appraisal instrument used to review staff performance and provide feedback to supervisors and managers. The Performance Management System Request for Proposal was issued January 12, 2009.

Harassment Prevention Policy Update

At its April 24, 2008 meeting, the Authority Board reviewed the Authority's Internet Use Policy, which discussion included the potential exposure of staff to offensive Internet materials in the course of their work, and the implications for the Authority's obligation to provide a harassment-free environment for its employees.

To this end, a working group was established and held their first meeting on August 28, 2008. The group met for three extended meetings under the facilitation of Ms. Gail Cecchettini Whaley of Hanson Bridgett, LLP, with the following objectives:

- Identify all potential offensive exposures to staff from a patron's Internet access.
- For each foreseeable exposure to offensive material, consider and catalog the most protective policy and protocol to protect employee rights that is consistent with the patron's right of access to protected materials.
- Recommend a comprehensive protocol taking into account the examples and precautions identified in the process.
- Recommend policy amendments to the Board for approval.

Ms. Whaley has prepared a detailed report on the Working Group's results, which will be presented to the Authority Board at its regular meeting on February 26, 2009.

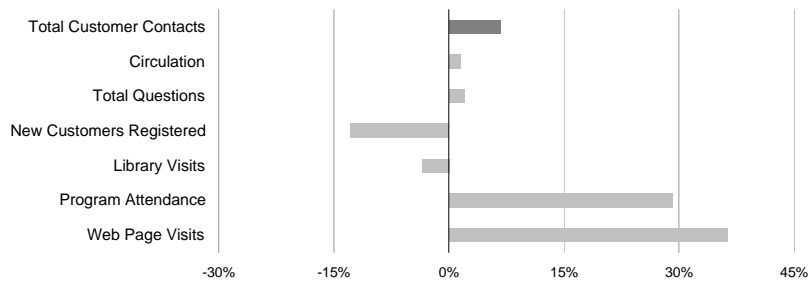

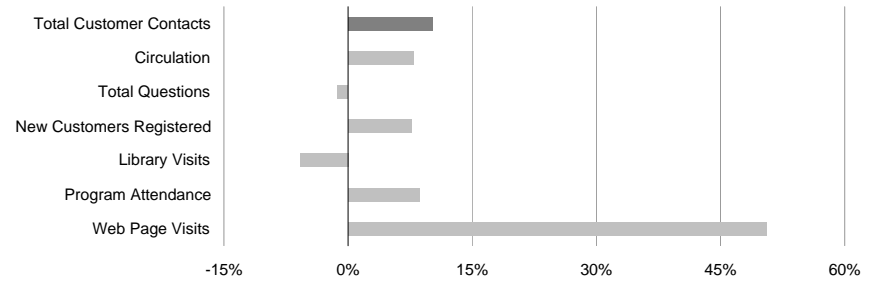

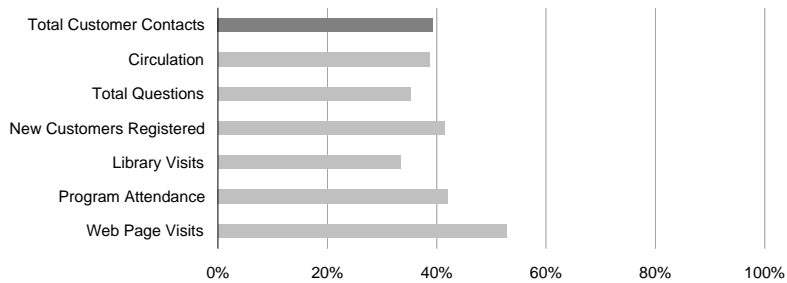
Month Percent Difference



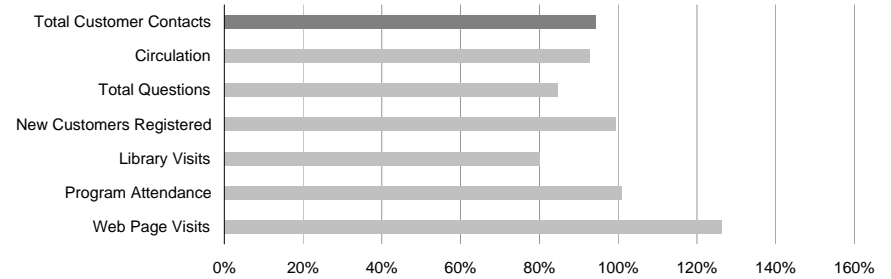
YTD Percent Difference

Projections as Percent of FY 2008-09 Goal

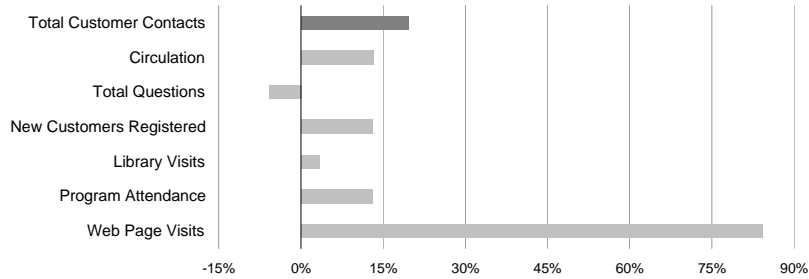

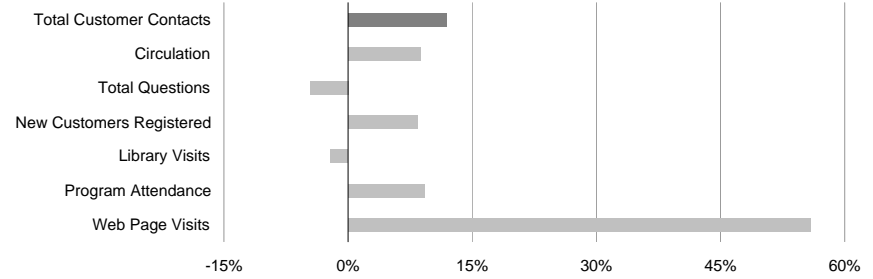

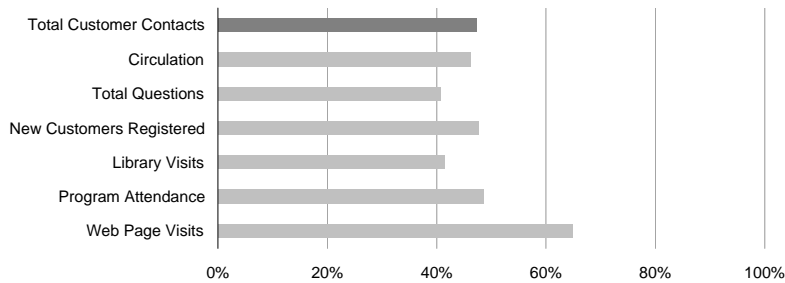
Month Percent Difference



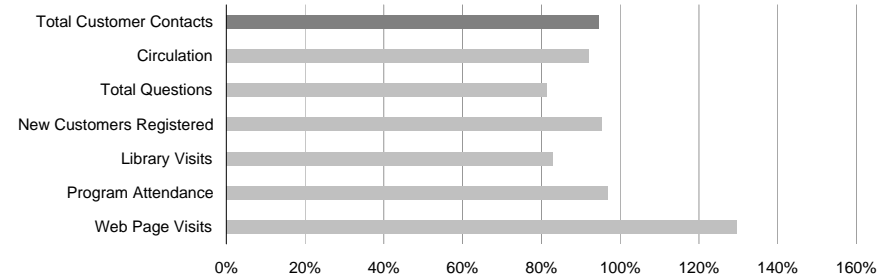
YTD Percent Difference

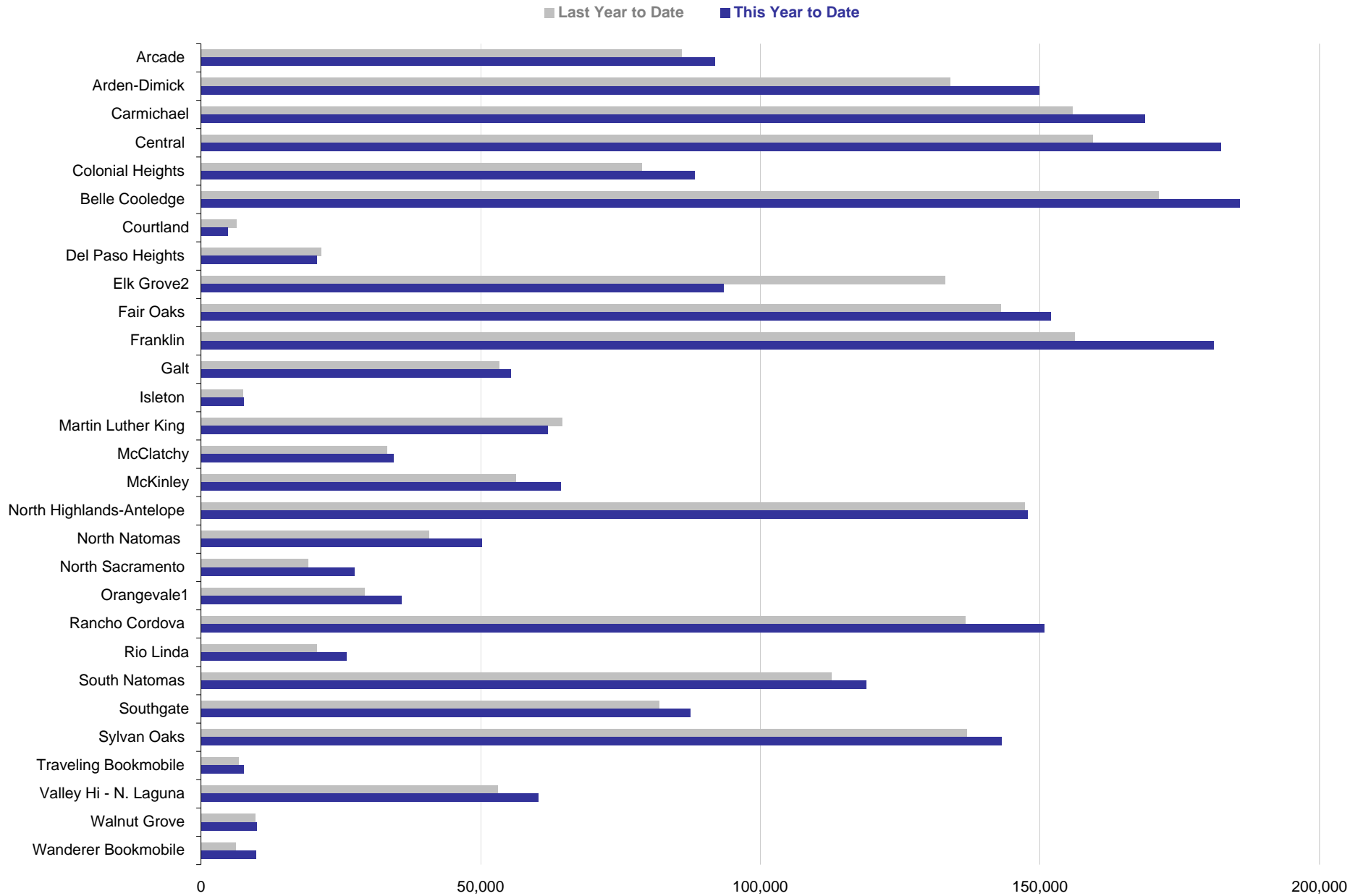

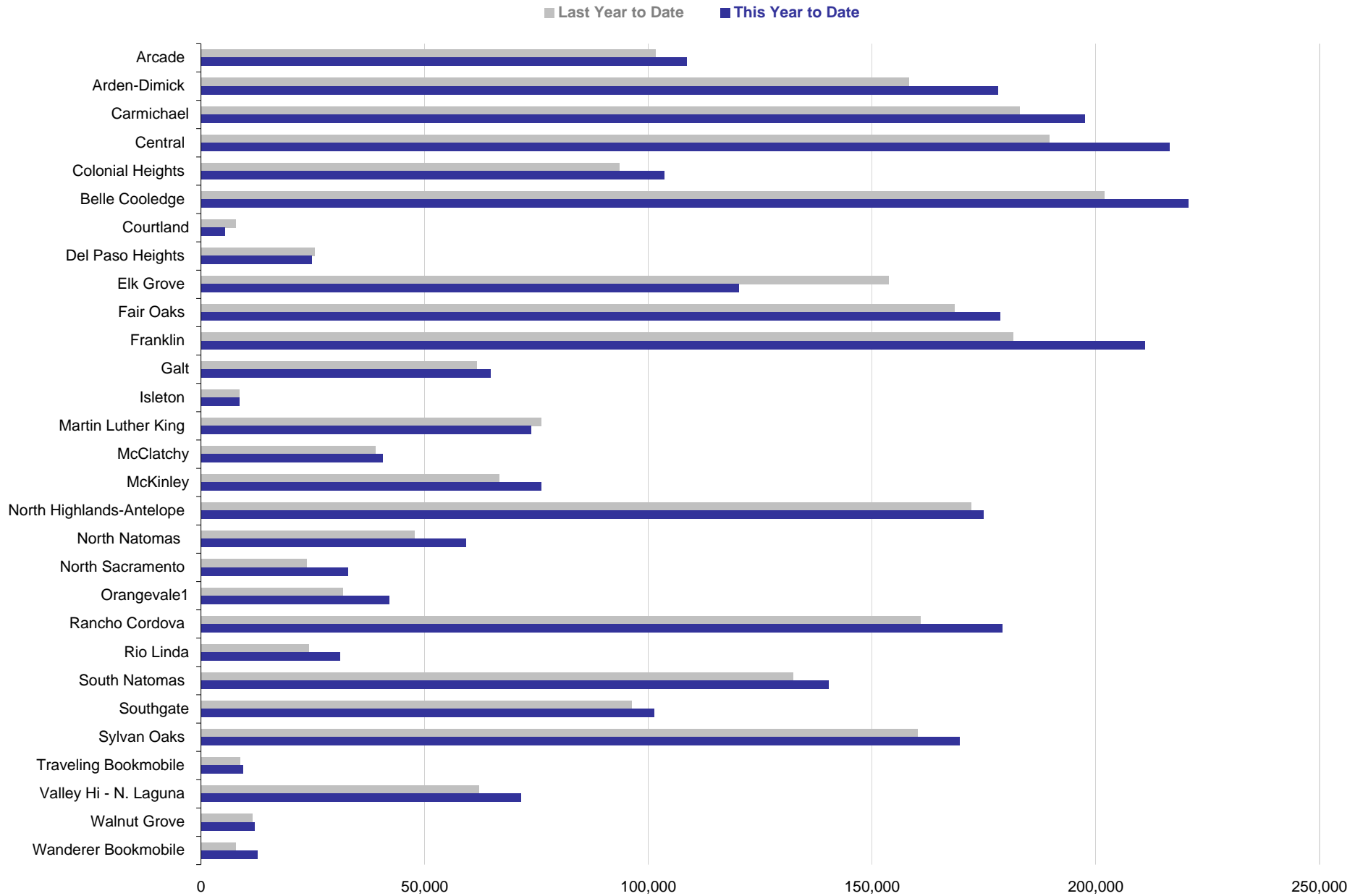

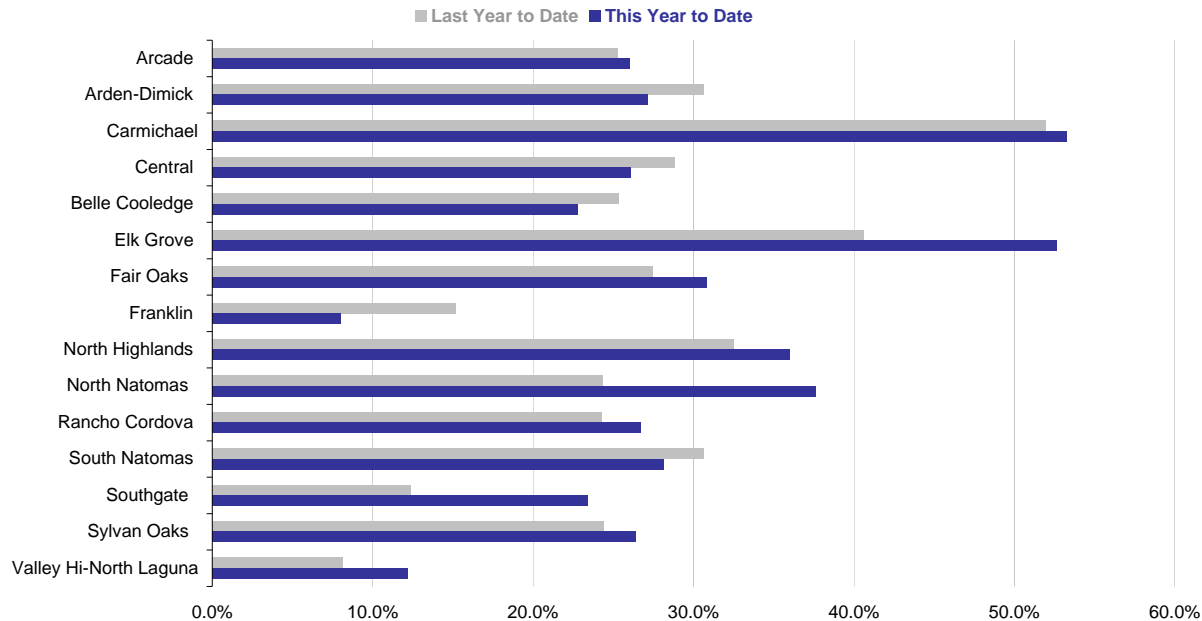

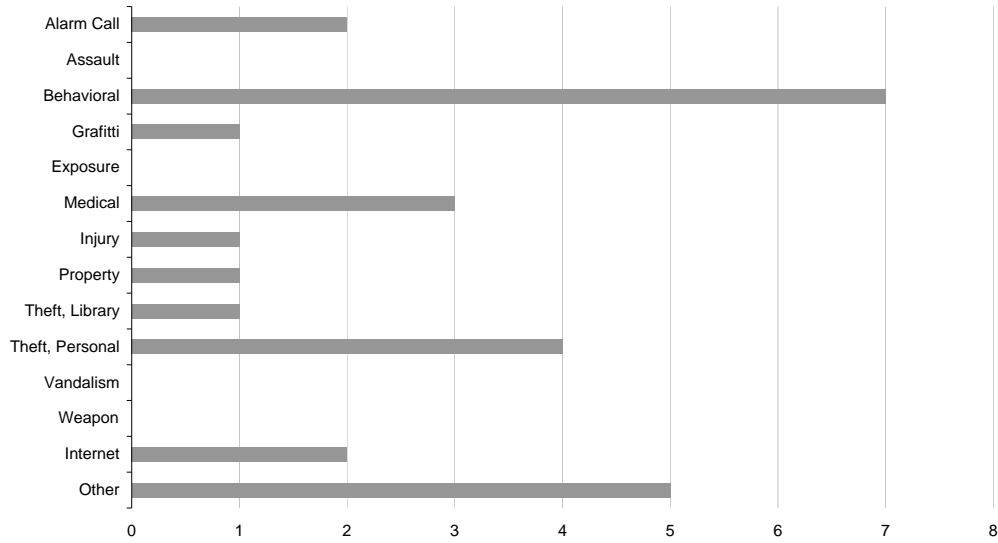

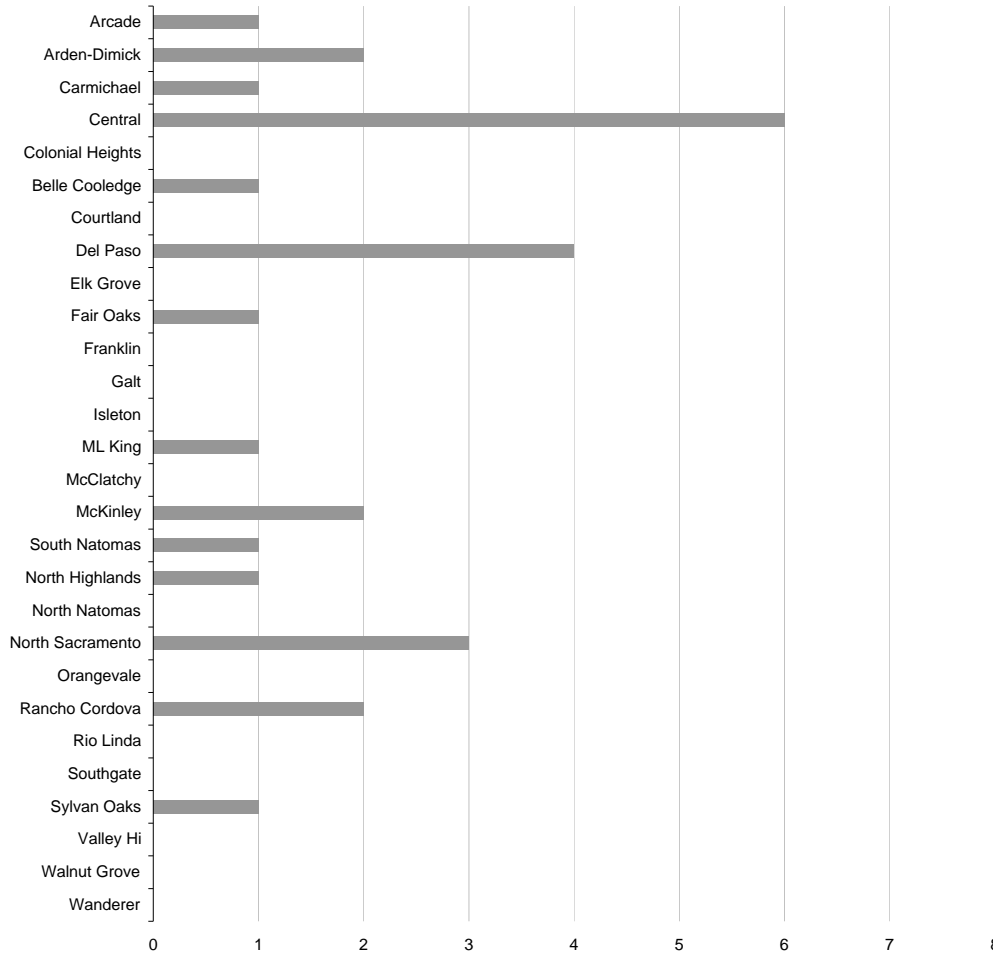

Security Incidents by Branch, October 2008

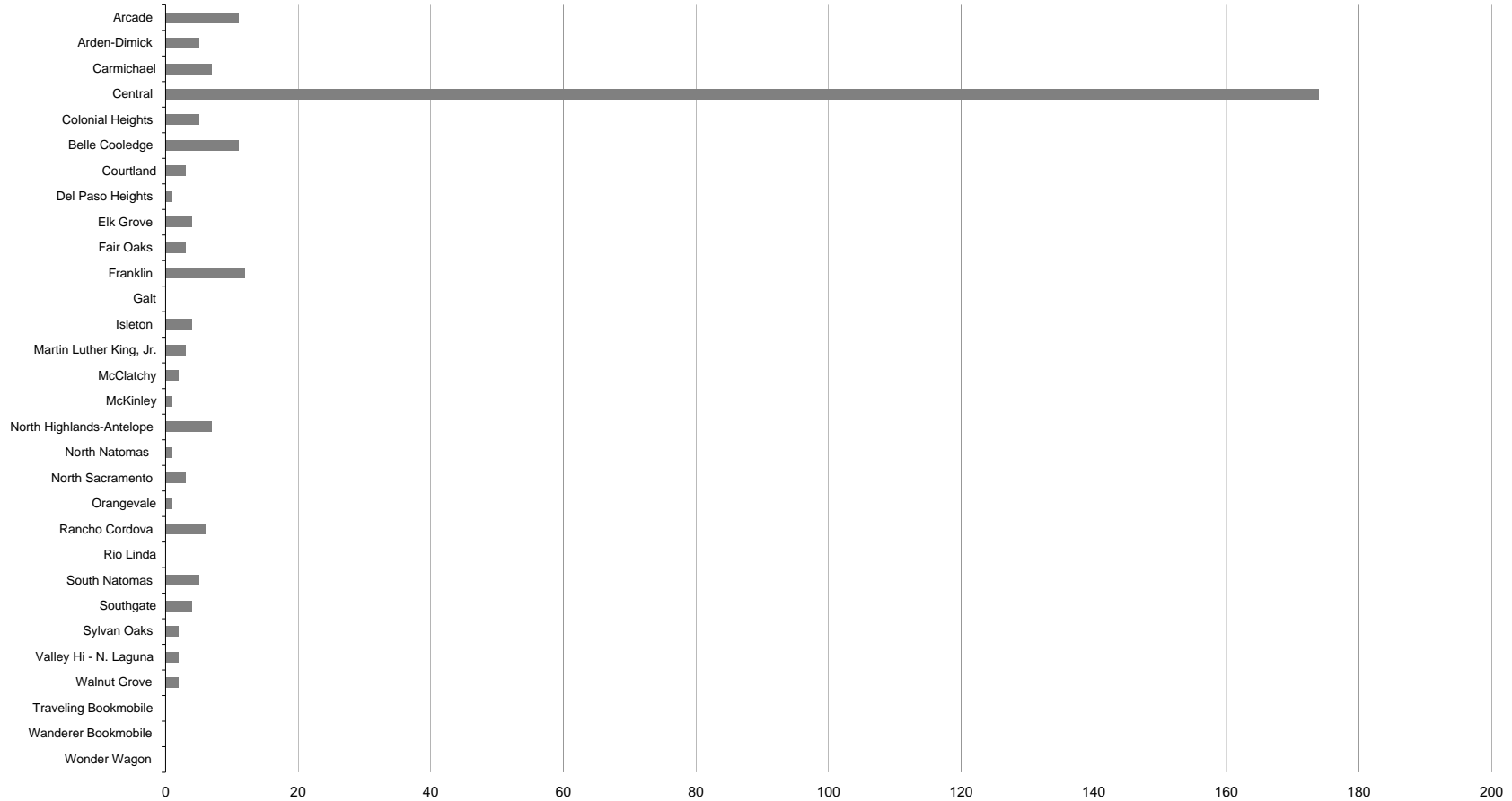

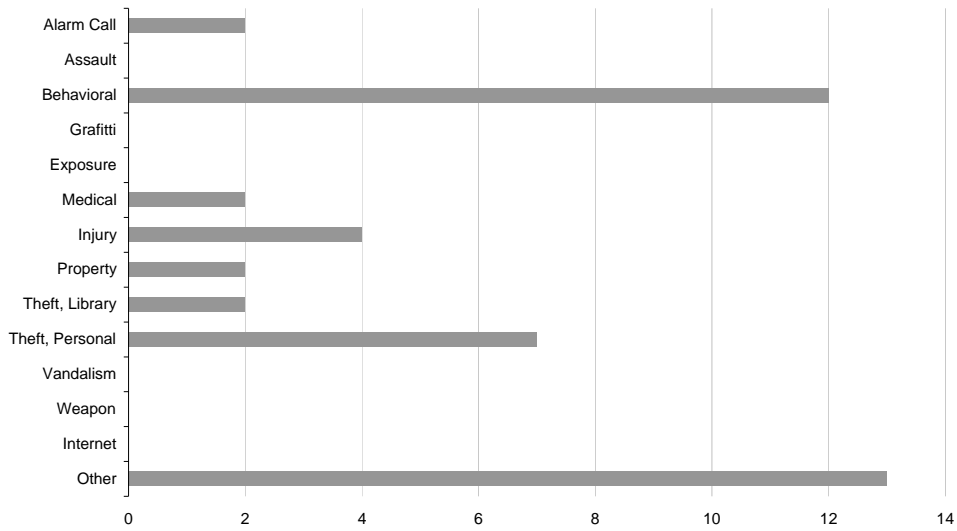

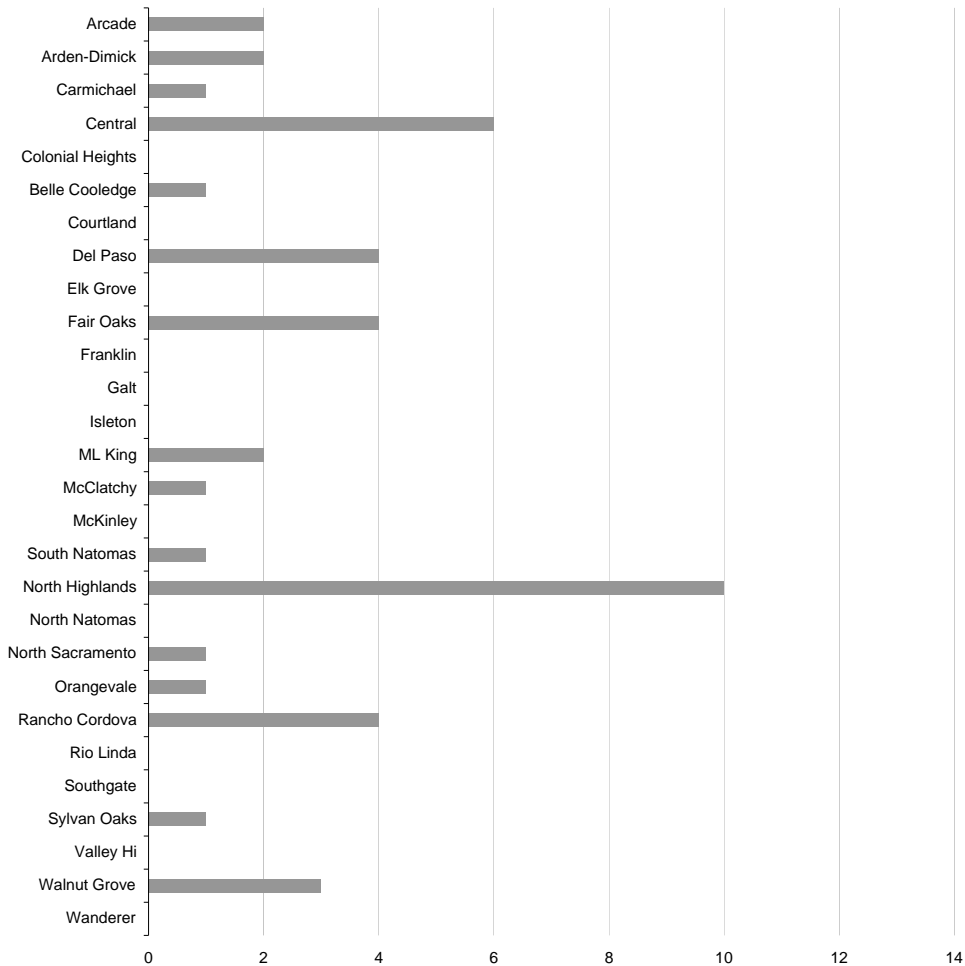
