#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):**

- 1. Accept** the FY 2010-11 California State Library Grant from the Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) for the Wonder of Reading Literacy Program, in the amount of \$160,389.
- 2. Approve** the FY 2010-11 Budget Amendment increasing revenue and expense budgets by \$160,389 for the LSTA Wonder of Reading Literacy Program.
- 3. Authorize** the Library Director to execute all necessary documents pertaining to the acceptance and expenditure of this grant on behalf of the Authority.

#### **REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION**

##### **The Wonder of Reading Literacy Program**

Funding through the Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) has allowed the California State Library to provide literacy support at Isleton Elementary School by placing a full-time credentialed teacher on-site to address the needs of 70 of the lowest performing children in the school and their families with English as a Second Language classes and other bi-lingual programs provided by staff at the Isleton Library adjacent to Isleton Elementary School.

The California State Library has approved the grant application from Sacramento Public Library for a total of \$160,389 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
