Anne M. Richardson Estate

Anne M. Richardson, a longtime friend of the Sacramento Public Library and a frequent volunteer at the Rancho Cordova branch, very generously left her estate to the Library for improvements at the branch. To date the Library has received \$350,000 from the estate. On February 7, 2011 the Library received the final distribution from the estate in the amount of \$58,010 bringing the total distribution received to \$408,010. A Final Trust Report is attached for your reference (see Attachment B).

The Library appreciates the efforts of Diane Balter in voluntarily serving as trustee for the estate and the many hours of work she put into the process of making this generous gift possible.

The Library will use the final distribution from the estate to complete the work on an automated materials handling system for the Rancho Cordova branch, a canopy for the book return area that will protect staff and materials from the elements, and a patio cover for the staff area.

Since the gifts and donations report runs through December 31, 2010, acceptance of these funds will be presented to the Board for acceptance at a future date.

Persian Language Advisory Committee

On January 26, 2011, a transfer of funds was made from the Sacramento Public Library Foundation to the Library Authority in the amount of \$16,313.74. The funds are from the accrued gifts from the Persian Language Advisory Committee and will be used to enhance Persian language programs and collections at Sacramento Public Library. Remaining funds held by the Foundation in an endowment (estimated at \$16,000) will be transferred to the Library Authority at a future date.

Foundation Report Correction

At the January meeting, Library staff provided the Authority Board with a spreadsheet that included detail regarding 2010 gifts and donations from the Friends and Foundation. Because an error was found in the spreadsheet, a corrected version is attached to this report (see Attachment C).

Friends of the Library Changes

Bob Gorham, longtime Friends of the Library member, was elected President of the System Friends for 2011. Bob follows Joanne Murphy in this role. Joanne will continue her role as warehouse manager at The Book Den.

In 2011 Library staff will work with the Friends on several new initiatives, including membership and improving information about the Friends that is presented on the **Library's website**, with the intended result of driving more traffic to the quarterly book sales.

Family Place Library at Southgate

The Sacramento Public Library Foundation has designated and contributed \$7,500 to be used as needed for the Family Place Library project at the Southgate branch. Funding for the project is coming from a variety of sources, including \$15,000 from the California State Library, \$1,700 from Southgate Friends of the Library, and \$11,500 from the Library Authority in cash and in-kind support. The Family Place Library model, which consists of providing developmentally appropriate spaces and resources, combined with focused early childhood programming, is a research-based program, with proven outcomes of increased pre-literacy skills and behaviors.

The Southgate branch closed on February 14 for a makeover anticipated to take three weeks. Work will focus on creating an early childhood space in the **Children's** area, creating a more open feel. New slat wall and countertops will be installed, and trim will be repainted, to further brighten the area. Developmentally appropriate books and toys, as well as child-sized furnishings, will be added, with parenting materials and a seating area designed for sharing books. The Friends have also purchased two AWE early learning computers, and are funding a new book sale space in the entrance area of the Library. A small opening celebration is planned for March 5th.

Lucky Day Collections

As part of the Library's efforts to improve access to our collections, we will be launching "Lucky Day" collections in our libraries this year. The traditional model for service has been to buy multiple copies of high demand items that library patrons may request and then wait in long queues to receive. The Lucky Day model allows the Library to purchase high demand materials that are not part of the holds process. A library user may check out a Lucky Day item for a single loan period of three-weeks before it is available for the next "lucky" user.

The Belle Cooledge Library is the first site for the Lucky Day launch, made possible by a generous gift of \$5,000 from the Friends of Belle Cooledge Library affiliate. Staff is working on the launch of Lucky Day collections at the Rio Linda, Elk Grove and McKinley libraries, scheduled for March. The comments of users at Belle Cooledge have been extremely positive and the expectation is that patrons in all locations will enjoy this new service.

Staff is hopeful that the Friends of the Library will assist in making these collections possible in all locations. To help the Friends determine fund raising targets, staff have developed recommendations relating to the cost.

Family Literacy Night in Isleton

On Thursday, February 3, Isleton branch supervisor Natalie Beaver, in partnership with the Isleton Elementary School, arranged a Family Literacy program. Author Matthew Gollub presented a lively evening of stories and music attended by 185 parents and students.

Mr. Gollub, founder of Tortuga Press (http://www.tortugapress.com), provided a program that highlighted reading together, reducing television and other screen time, and reading for pleasure. Parents and students alike were very engaged in the event.

As previously reported to the Board, Sacramento Public Library Authority is collaborating on a grant with the Wonder of Reading Foundation. This program ties in with the grant objectives.

Sincere thanks go to the Friends of the Isleton Library for their help in partially funding this event.

826 Valencia Partnership

Sacramento Public Library is pleased to be partnering with other community stakeholders to explore and implement after school programs for students, ages 6 – 18, to help them improve their reading and writing skills.

Funded by a grant from the Albert & Elaine Borchard Foundation, Inc., 21 stakeholders, including community leaders, library staff, and nonprofit staff, attended training in San Francisco to learn about the 826 Valencia model. Founded in 2002 by author Dave Eggers and educator Nínive Calegari, 826 Valencia is dedicated to supporting students, ages 6 to 18, with their writing skills and to helping teachers get their students excited about writing.

A follow up meeting was held on Saturday, February 12; 826 team members discussed how to develop scalable models in Sacramento, including the idea of at least one center in a library branch, what funding might be available and how volunteers will be recruited and trained.

Strong reading and writing skills are fundamental to future success, and great leaps in learning can be made when skilled tutors work one-on-one with students. The 826 model uses volunteers from throughout the community and is one that can be replicated and sustained here in the Sacramento area when the right people come together. It is essential that Sacramento Public Library be part of this exciting effort. In addition to serving as the fiscal agent for the grant, Library staff is involved in the planning.

Reward for Arden-Dimick Incident

The library is working with an investigator from Sacramento Metropolitan Fire regarding the reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons involved in the January 3, 2011, incident. A copy of the surveillance video has been provided to the fire department for further review. Authorities were unable to recover any fingerprints from the hammer found in the book drop.

Big Read Grant

Library staff is actively pursuing grants for programs and services. On February 1, a grant was submitted to the National Endowment for the Arts for The Big Read. If funded, the title submitted with the grant application will be Sacramento Public Library's 2011 One Book Sacramento title.

American Sabor Exhibition

Later this spring, Sacramento Public Library will host the kick-off for the national tour of the *American Sabor: Latinos in U.S. Popular Music* exhibition, organized for travel by the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Services (SITES) and funded by the Ford Motor Company Fund, the philanthropic arm of Ford Motor Company. The *American Sabor* exhibition tells the story of the influence of post World War II Latin music in the United States. The panel exhibit explores the social history and individual creativity that produced major stars such as Tito Puente, Ritchie Valens, Celia Cruz, Carlos Santana and others.

The Library is planning an exciting series of programs related to the exhibition and its themes. These programs will take place at the Central Library and selected library branches. A kick-off for community leaders will be held on March 24. The exhibition will open to the public on May 26 and will close on August 7.

Internet and Wireless Usage in Libraries

At the January 27, 2011 meeting, Director Serna asked for additional information about patrons who are using Library computers and wireless access, and whether the Library is their only point of access. Staff answered that national studies have indicated that for approximately 70% of those using computers in libraries, the library is indeed their sole source of access to the Internet.

A listing of wireless "hotspots" in Sacramento is attached (Attachment D), but does not reflect that wireless access is available in every Sacramento Public Library location. In order to gather local data regarding users, Library staff will develop a survey for public Internet computers that will launch during login, as well as surveys for our catalog and wireless users. A timeline will be provided in March.

65th and Folsom

Library staff have met with Sacramento City Councilmembers Steve Cohn and Kevin McCarty, along with representatives from SHRA and SETA, to discuss a pilot project for a storefront e-library concept in the 65th and Folsom area of Sacramento. Library staff are acutely aware that this area is underserved and would like to come up with a concept that is affordable, sustainable and serves the community in that area. The initial concept is to provide a wifi-enabled space that is open evenings, which might also serve as a pick up and drop off site for library materials. Staff will continue to keep the Board informed as plans develop.

Honorable Members in Session:

As Trustee of the Anne M. Richardson Family Trust, I present the Trustee's final report of trust administration.

Anne Richardson was a long-time, dedicated volunteer at the Rancho Cordova Branch of the Sacramento Public Library. While she performed many duties, she was especially devoted to repairing books in need of loving attention. During her lifetime, Ms. Richardson established a revocable family trust and named the Rancho Cordova Branch as her beneficiary:

After my death, the Trustee shall liquidate my entire Trust estate and distribute the proceeds outright to the Rancho Cordova Branch of THE SACRAMENTO PUBLIC LIBRARY, to be used for enlargement of their workroom, or if this has previously been accomplished, to enlarge the library proper.

Mrs. Richardson further provided:

If for any reason, the Library fails to act on the above within eighteen (18) months, this gift shall lapse and the entire Trust estate shall be distributed to THE SACRAMENTO SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS, to be used for whatever purpose they deem useful and appropriate.

Mrs. Richardson died on January 15, 2008. In her Declaration of Trust, Mrs. Richardson designated her brother, David Suffia, as successor Trustee. Mr. Suffia lives out-of-state and declined to serve. Mrs. Richardson had designated her close friend, Brandi Hardin, as the second successor Trustee, but Ms. Hardin also declined to serve. Thus, there was no one to serve as Trustee to liquidate Mrs. Richardson's assets and distribute them according to the terms of the Trust.

Because the Library was to be the sole beneficiary of the Trust, Mrs. Richardson's attorney, Mark Drobny, contacted the Library Director to seek her assistance in identifying an individual to undertake the duties of the Trustee. At the time, I was part-time General Counsel for the Library Authority. When no other appropriate solution was found, I volunteered to serve as Trustee. I have not been compensated by the Library Authority or the Trust for the time devoted to trust administration.

All of the assets were liquidated by the end of 2008. The net proceeds were \$443,437.97. A summary of receipts and expenses is attached as Attachment 1. More detailed financial records are available upon request.

A preliminary distribution of \$350,000.00 was disbursed to the Library Authority on September 18, 2008. A final distribution of \$58,010 was disbursed on February 7, 2011, for a total of \$408,010.

Phase 1 of the Rancho Cordova workroom project has been completed. The staff workroom is larger, ergonomically improved, more efficient, and more pleasant. Staff is now working on Phase 2.

Mrs. Richardson specifically directed that her gift be used for enlargement of the workroom or another part of the library, and the Trustee is responsible to ensure that the money is used for the specified purpose. Because some of the improvements and additions to the staff room do not literally "enlarge" the workroom, there was the possibility that a dispute might arise concerning the propriety of all of the expenditures. In particular, contingent beneficiary Sacramento SPCA might take the position that some of the funds were not properly used and that the Library Authority or the Trustee was legally required to make a substantial payment to the SPCA.

To bring certainty for all parties, the Trustee proposed a distribution of approximately \$30,000.00 of the Trust proceeds to the SSPCA in return for their releasing any potential claim to any other Trust proceeds. Subsequent to the Authority's acceptance of this report, the Trustee intends to disburse to the

SSPCA the sum of \$30,790.00, which is just under 7% of the net Trust proceeds. This payment to the SSPCA still leaves the Library with adequate funds to complete Phase 2, based on preliminary cost estimates. The Library Director has also executed a release that approves this modest, but meaningful, contribution to the SSPCA, another organization close to Mrs. Richardson's heart.

Approximately \$5,000 is reserved for final expenses of administration. Any unspent funds will be disbursed to the SSPCA, which could increase the SSPCA share of net proceeds from just under 7% to no more than 8%.

The Trustee is pleased to have contributed her time and energy to fulfill Mrs. Richardson's desire for important improvements to the Rancho Cordova staff workroom. She extends special thanks to Brandi Hardin for Ms. Hardin's ongoing assistance and to Mrs. Richardson's other colleagues in the Rancho Cordova Friends of the Library who were such a large part of what inspired Mrs. Richardson's generosity toward the Library.

Key Points:

- · Year to date circulation for FY 2010-11 is 5.1% above last year's year to date circulation.
- FY 2010-11 year to date self-check circulation is just over 2 million, a 29.4% increase from FY 2009-1 This also accounts for 43.5% of total circulation.
- Branches with the highest percentage of circulation that is from self-check include:

Elk Grove (80.2%) Colonial Heights (75.3%) Valley Hi-North Laguna (72.3%) North Natomas (70.7%)

- In January 2011, the Library offered 393 free programs to the public, a 33.7% increase from January 2010.
- FY 2010-11 year to date program attendance is 71,048, a 21.2% increase from FY 2009-10
- FY 2010-11 year to date volunteer hours is 27,214, a 12.9% increase from FY 2009-10


