RE: Local Telephone Service Contract

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

ADOPT Resolution #13-01, a resolution approving a contract for local telephone service with AT&T for three years in an amount not to exceed \$480,000.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION(S)

At its February 28, 2008, meeting, the Authority Board approved a five-year contract for telecommunication services for local telephone services with AT&T. The contract was based on negotiated CALNET2 pricing between the California Department of General Services and AT&T. The CALNET2 contract expires in January 2014.

In December 2012, the Library issued a Request for Bid (RFB) for negotiated local telephone services from vendors participating in the Universal Service Schools and Libraries Program commonly known as "E-Rate." Vendors were asked to complete a list of library sites requiring Centrex-based services and features, measured business lines and related telecommunication services.

Four vendors submitted responses to the RFB, including AT&T, Frontier Communications, SureWest and TelePacific. Upon review of vendor proposals, AT&T offered the lowest price for requested services.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Library will apply to continue to receive a 71% discount on telecommunication services, including local telephone services. Upon approval of application, the library is automatically eligible to receive an additional 50% discount from the California Teleconnect Fund.
