In July 2020, Sacramento Public Library began renovation and expansion of the Orangevale Library to better meet the needs of the community. Improvements make the library fully ADA accessible and nearly doubles its footprint from 4,320 square feet to 7,910 square feet. The \$950,000 expansion includes a new community room, dedicated spaces designed for teens and children, study rooms, more computers for public use



and an enhanced collection. This is the second expansion of the library, which has been located at 8820 Greenback Lane since 2001. The Orangevale Library has been serving the community since 1912.




